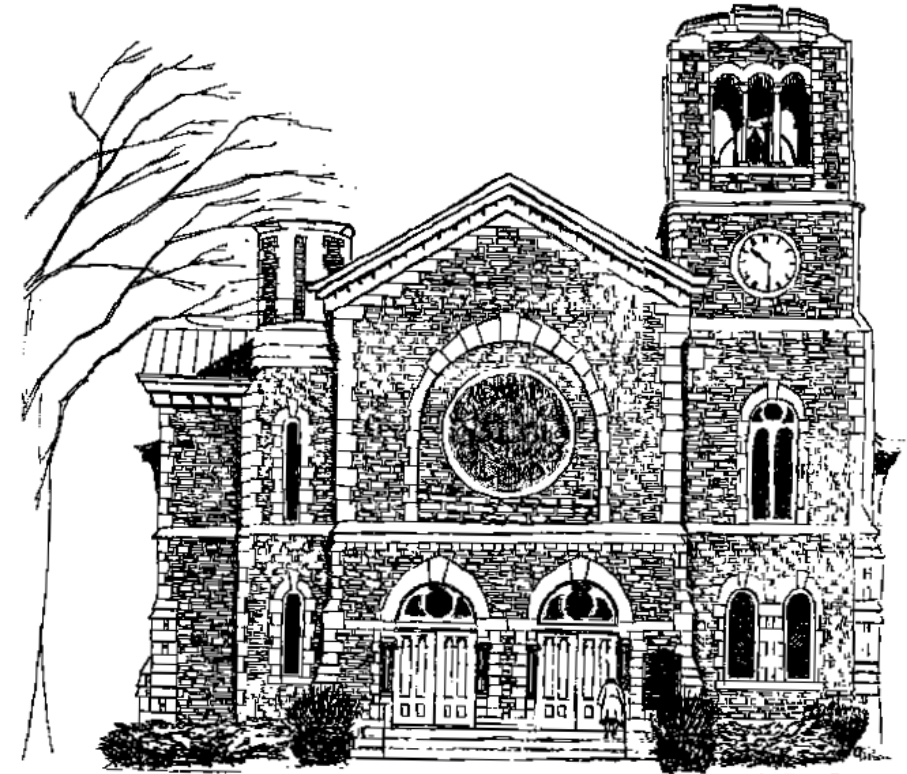


**“Prepare the Way, O Zion”**
