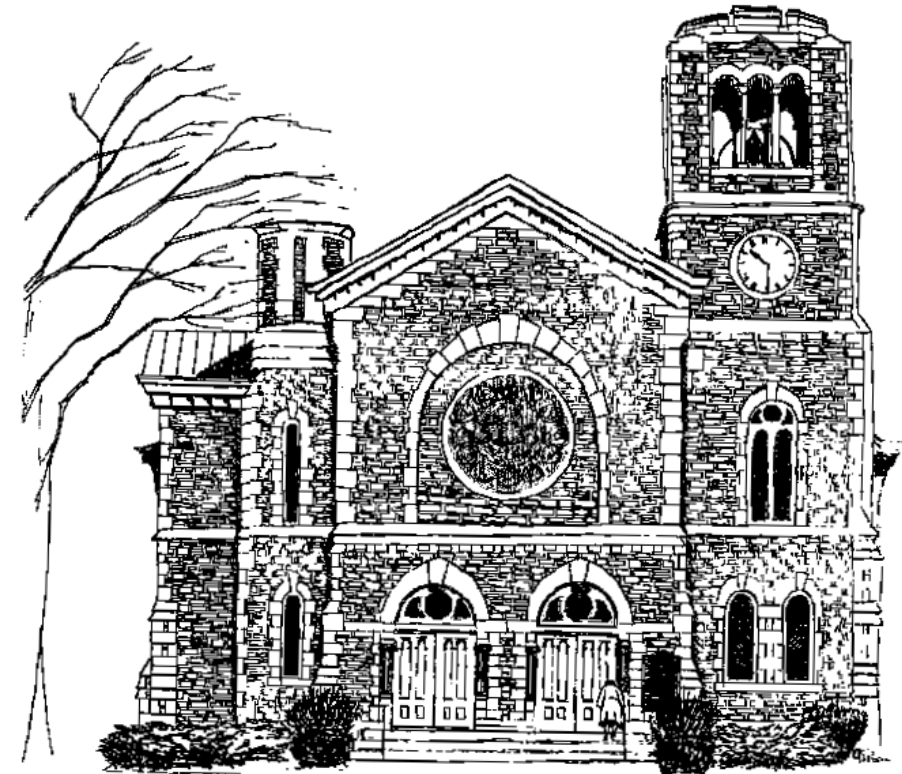
SWEET LAMB OF GOD
